Ulla's fun and educative public workshops serve the full spectrum of the community, and they are great activities in schools or at festivals.









PUBLIC WORKSHOP IN CHALK PASTELS

The general public is invited to join in colouring a design, with artist tips, techniques. Beautifully coloured chalk and and artists pastels are supplied.

INTENSIVE WORKSHOP

Ulla works with ~10 participants over 3 hours - 2 full days or more -formats are flexible. An introduction to materials/ tools, techniques, history, creating "3d" - and then we create our own pavement artworks in a conTemporary gallery.

ARTIST DISPLAY

Inspire and educate via live painting! Ulla is an expert "3D" illusion creator on pavements, creating great interactive photo opportunities. She also creates murals on walls, and creates event artworks for installation.



PUBLIC WORKSHOPS

for casual involvement

Art Snake is ideal for busy events...

The public work on their chalk drawings for 10 minutes to an hour or more, depending on their energy/inspiration and time, and can colour multiple spaces if they wish.



Adaptable to any theme

Ulla paints out the design in advance, allowing (eg~120) spaces for passers-by of all ages to come and draw what they like in the giant serpent or other design.

ENVIRONMENT & ANIMALS


For Frog Week at Melbourne Zoo, a frog river was created by Zoo visitors...

MAJOR EVENTS

Working with a contracted team and/or support staff Ulla has created major Pavement Art events, such as-







MELBOURNE MUSEUM- THE BIG DRAW

Ulla contracted Chalk Circle artists to assist with the suppost of Melbourne Museum staff to create the "Big Draw". School groups were guided through an introductory chat, sketching the natural history exhibits, and then added to the "Giant Pencil" mural (primary groups and weekend visitors) and Contemporary Gallery (secondary groups). It was a huge project over many days, and the Museum won an award via the Big Draw festival (a world-wide event).

HANDS ON PEACE

As a part of Windsor Primary Art Show, Ulla worked with the whole school to create this beautiful artwork.











MAJOR EVENTS









MOOMBA -ARTPLAY WITH ZEST EVENTS

Ulla worked with Zest Events supported by Art Play on this large event. Ulla designed and painted out the Moomba Boomerang with native animal motifs, (lizard, dolphin butterfly and platypus) - then trained other Zest artists in her workshop format. With Zest support crew, we gave a Pavement Art intro and history talk at Art Play, and then guided groups of children up to the Fed Square carpark to create this Huge mural



INTENSIVE WORKSHOP

CASE STUDY - Anti Grafitti Pavement art workshop

A four day Chalk Art workshop over two weeks, students created a variety of independent and group art works in an Anti-Grafitti campaign. Texture, perspective and advanced Street Painting pavement art t and pastel techniques.









TECH INFO



NON TOXIC

Tempera paints and artists
pastels, supplemented by quality
chalk for bright, colourful effects
- gently fixed to the ground so as
not to smudge, are used for
pavement art.

In Painting Workshops, Ulla prefers to brush paint with acrylics -avoiding toxic fumes from spray cans.



TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT

The workshop artworks can last from days to weeks slowly fading from the surface,

Longevity is dependent on the surface porosity and texture, the colours chosen by the artists (some are innately more robust), the skill / time spent by participants affixing their work.

Some pavement art can last for months, even with pastel, Ulla herself uses artist-quality, pure pigment pastel which can last years in protected spaces.

Ulla recommends that the artwork it left to fade gracefully so it can be enjoyed by passers by over time.

Specalist mural and paving paints can also be used for more permanent works.
